Scope of Asset Management

- In this paper: AM/ SAM only in the field of Water and Wastewater
- What are ASSETS, only buildings, equipment, tools, pipes, machinery?
- Or: also natural resources, human resources, financial resources?
- If considering all these subjects ⇒

Asset Management reality

- All Water & Wastewater utilities manage their assets to some extent.
- Many don't realize that they are practicing Asset Management
- E.g.: they have no written guidelines about their Asset Management (e.g. common in continental Europe)

What is Asset Management?

E.g. according to the EPA Handbook (2003):

- Asset Management is a planning process
 - to get most volume from each asset
 - to have financial resources to maintain / rehabilitate sustainably assets
- Planning to reduce costs while increasing efficiency and reliability of assets



But several other definitions are used!

State of the Art of (S)AM:

H. Allegre (2006): Hundreds of definitions, some of which are:

- AM is a business process and decisionsupport framework
- AM is a planning process
- AM is an information based process

Starting Point for Common Understanding

- Several different understandings and definitions of AM/SAM
- Serious discussion/research/development of guidelines need answers to these questions:
 - Who knows what is AM/SAM?
 - Those who talk about it?
 - Those, who do it and know it, but don't talk about it?
 - Those, who do it, but are not aware that they do it?
 - Those that do it and talk about it?

Work in the field

- Input from all groups is necessary
- Go into the field, to the:
 - operators
 - mangers
 - owners
 - funding organisations (governments, donors, investors) -
 - and very important
 - users who pay for the services

Taxonomy of Asset Management

- Gather existing information, documents
- Find common contents
- Put some kind of order in AM/SAM
 - ⇒"Taxonomy" of Asset Management (orders, families and species of Asset Management)
 - ⇒ Survey/"Questionaire"

For Survey: Questions to Utilities

- What are your assets / is their value?
- What management practices are in place?
- What kind of Asset Management (AM) is in place?
- What does AM mean to you?
- What are the benefits of AM?
- What could be the benefits of AM?
- What are the costs of AM?
- What is the alternative to AM?





Research Needs for (S)AM

GWCG General Water Consult Corp austrianwate

Scope of Survey / Research

- Adapted to understanding of those being surveyed – tailored to each group, e.g.
 - large utilies small utilities
 - "rich" and "non-rich" countries
- World-wide Projects (ideally)
- Regional Projects (probably)
- Who: Team of Experts in (S)AM from Utilities / Operators, Research Institutes, Universities, Consultants
- With involvement of financial players + regional associations (e.g. EWA, AWWA)

Research Needs for (S)AM



Common "Philosophy"

- Diverse situations of utilities
 - ⇒ tailor made guideline for AM / SAM for each utility
- Worldwide / continent-wide
 General Guideline / Standard only as a base
 for tailor made guideline for each utility



■ Different approaches must have a place within a common understanding of AM/SAM ⇒ "Global Manifest on AM/SAM"

Explanatory Documentation

- These new, "global" documents (Manifest, Glossary) have to be seen in the light of the many existing documents, standards, guidelines, etc.
- The relationship between these "global" documents and the existing, regional or national documents should be made transparent
 - ⇒ SAM Explanatory Documentation.





Research Needs for (S)AM



Common Terminology / Glossary

- Common terminology, limited to important terms
- At least: "translation guide" for those using different words for the same thing
- SAM International Glossary

however

Definitions cannot be a goal for their own sake but rather instruments for the implementation of AM/SAM





Research Needs for (S)AM



Results of this Reseach Strategy

Common AS/SAM understanding and terminology

can be used to

- formulate policies on AS/SAM
- formulate and implement AS/SAM strategies
- develop standards and guidelines
- support education and training

Research Needs for (S)AM

- enormous increase of interest and development of methodologies is evident
- increasing need for guidance and standards
- a result of the intended research works: identify the necessary contents and depth of detail for such guidance documents
- consideration about the level on which such documents should be developed: national, regional (e.g. CEN, EWA, AWWA) or international (e.g. ISO, IWA).
- role of SAM in regulation of utilities will probably increase
- SAM may be included both in voluntary and in legal regulations
- SAM may be required by important donor organizations such as the World Bank, Regional Development Banks / Institutions, but also by national funding agencies.
